

Installation FAQs

We want to install the NYSE® Desktop Notices & Alerts, what do we need?

You need to install the Google Desktop at the user's machines, and allow then to install the NYSE® Desktop Notices & Alerts.

We don't want our end users to install any other Google Gadget, what we can do?

The Enterprise version of the Google Desktop allows you to create a white list of allowed gadgets. This is a list of gadgets ids that the user will be able to install at their machines, if you want to allow the user to install the Analog Clock Gadget, the following Id would be in the list: {DF83CBC5-6FAD-4074-BF03-8254392DEFA0}
