Andretti Gets Hard-Fought Fourth-Place Finish at Kentucky in NYSE Car

SPARTA, Ky. (Aug. 11, 2007) – Marco Andretti started 15th and used the entire 200-lap race to work to the top five at Saturday night’s Meijer Indy 300 presented by Coca-Cola at Kentucky Speedway. It was Andretti’s fifth top-five finish in the last seven races in the NYSE car.

Andretti entered his initial pit stop on lap 38 having already gained three spots and was sitting 12th. The NYSE crew gained him two positions during the stop and he exited 10th. On lap 125, Andretti was sitting eighth following another pit stop. Andretti gradually picked off other drivers and was in the top five on lap 162. He was running fourth when the yellow flag came out on lap 183, where he would stay during the final 10 laps of green-flag racing.

Andretti’s teammate Tony Kanaan captured his second-consecutive victory, only the 15th time that has happened in IndyCar Series history. Scott Dixon, A.J. Foyt IV and Tomas Scheckter finished second, third and fifth, respectively.

The next race on the IndyCar Series schedule is the Motorola Indy 300 at Infineon Raceway. The 15th of 17 IndyCar Series races on the 2007 schedule will be broadcast live by ESPN at 3:30 p.m. (EDT) on Sunday, Aug. 26. The race can also be heard live on XM Satellite Radio channel 145, the exclusive home of the IndyCar Series.

Marco Andretti, #26 NYSE Dallara/Honda/Firestone:

"The balance of the NYSE car was good, but it might have been too good, which took away from our speed. It’s a balancing act for sure. We’ve got to find a faster car that we can hold onto. We weren’t too far off of the setup of Tony’s (Kanaan) car. The car was good; it just wasn’t quick enough to challenge Tony or Dario (Franchitti)."

Kyle Moyer, Race Strategist, #26 NYSE Dallara/Honda/Firestone:

"In the second part of the season we’ve taken on the attitude that it is a war out there and that we just have to drive through the field, which is part of the learning process. These last three oval races, Marco’s driven tough and has gotten great results. From now on I think he can drive the NYSE car through anything; he proved that tonight."
