## Accident Ends Andretti's Day at Milwaukee in NYSE Car

**WEST ALLIS, Wis. (June 3, 2007)** – Marco Andretti, driver of the #26 NYSE car, was nearing his second top-10 finish of the 2007 season when he got out of the groove on a late-race restart, into the marbles and found the wall. Andretti finished 15<sup>th</sup> at Sunday's running of the ABC Supply Co./A.J. Foyt 225 at The Milwaukee Mile.

Starting 14<sup>th</sup>, Andretti quickly gained ground on the field, picking up three positions on the opening lap of the race. As the race progressed, Andretti moved into and stayed among the top-10 cars. Despite falling a lap down, the NYSE team made crafty pit decisions and was able to return Andretti to the lead-lap for a final charge at the race leaders.

Andretti's teammate, Tony Kanaan, won the ninth IndyCar Series race of his career and his second win of the 2007 season. AGR driver Dario Franchitti finished second and was followed across the line by Dan Wheldon, Scott Dixon and Vitor Meira.

The Bombardier Learjet 550 is the next race on the IndyCar Series schedule. ESPN2 will provide live coverage of the event from Texas Motor Speedway beginning at 9:30 p.m. (EDT). The race can also be heard live on XM Satellite Radio, channel 145, the exclusive home of the IndyCar Series.

### Marco Andretti, #26 NYSE Dallara/Honda/Firestone:

"I'm incredibly disappointed for the NYSE team. We had a decent race going today and I got into the marbles and just lost the car. We made a few changes near the end of the race that made the NYSE car much better and I think we would have had a solid finish today."

### Kyle Moyer, Race Strategist, #26 NYSE Dallara/Honda/Firestone:

"On our last pit stop, we put on a new set of tires because last year we didn't put on a new set of tires and we dropped from second to sixth with 15 laps to go. So, this time we decided to put on some tires to make a run, so we were asking a lot out of the NYSE car. Marco was trying to pass people as quickly as he could on the restart and he got up into the gray part of the track. Once you are in that area, you're in trouble and we hit the wall."
