## Andretti Collects Top-Five Finish at The Glen in NYSE Car

**WATKINS GLEN, N.Y. (July 8, 2007)** – Marco Andretti drove to a fifth-place finish at Watkins Glen International in the #26 NYSE car Sunday. It was Andretti's second fourth-place finish in two road course events on the season.

Andretti moved into the top five on Turn 1 of the first lap of the 60-lap race and stayed among the leaders for the entire race. The NYSE team decided to use a different fuel strategy than the leading cars when they pitted for fuel on lap 22. Andretti exited the pits in 11<sup>th</sup> place, but was second on his sequence. As the race leaders began to pit at the midway point of the race, Andretti took the overall race lead and stayed there for several laps until his next pit stop. Because eventual race winner Scott Dixon and second-place driver Sam Hornish Jr. were able to stay out longer than Andretti during their second fuel stint, they were able to make quicker final pit stops and both drivers were able to get ahead of the NYSE car. The finish was Andretti's third top-five finish of the season and his second in the last three races.

Dixon captured his third-consecutive win at The Glen, followed by Hornish. Andretti Green Racing teammates Dario Franchitti and Tony Kanaan finished third and fourth, respectively.

The IndyCar Series schedule resumes Saturday, July 14, from Nashville Superspeedway. ESPN will provide live broadcast coverage of the Firestone Indy 200 beginning at 7:30 p.m. (EDT). The race can also be heard live on XM Satellite Radio channel 145, the exclusive home of the IndyCar Series.

### Marco Andretti, #26 NYSE Dallara/Honda/Firestone:

"Today was a good day for the NYSE team. We had to stretch our fuel on our second stint and were able to do that and still stay near the front. We've got another solid finish under our belt and we'll move on to Nashville."

### Kyle Moyer, Race Strategist, #26 NYSE Dallara/Honda/Firestone:

"We didn't have a winning car today so we tried to use some pit strategy to get in front and we just fell short. We just need to keep working on the car because it wasn't that good. Marco drove the wheels off the thing and that's what we ask him to do."
