NYSE does not charge for any Bank Fees. Bank Fees are charged to overseas (Foreign) accounts by an intermediary bank if your bank does not have a direct method to send payment(s) to a US Bank, in that case those accounts require an intermediary bank to act as an agent in the US.

Please comply with the above instructions on Field 71A to avoid these charges. The field should state **OUR**, if not then it defaults to BNF, which is the Bank Fee charged by an intermediary bank before the funds are remitted to JP Morgan Chase which in turn facilitates payment to the NYSE. Please check with your bank to advise who the intermediary bank is and review their fees. That fee needs to be added to the invoice total in order for NYSE to receive total balance that is owed on the invoice.
