FINRA (Financial Industry Regulatory Authority, Inc.) requires firms to report short interest positions in all customer and proprietary accounts in all equity securities twice a month. All short interest positions must be reported by 6 p.m. Eastern Time on the second business day after the reporting settlement date designated by FINRA.

The NYSE Group Short Interest file is available via subscription, biweekly for that contains the reported uncovered short positions of securities on NYSE, NYSE Arca and NYSE American. This file is available to firms via SFTP and Amazon Simple Storage Solution (AWS S3). With the NYSE Group Short Interest data, customers may develop risk and trading models for NYSE-listed issues.
