SUBJECT: Post Trade Test Output for Backup Servers at Mahwah Data Center

On Saturday, **April 2, 2011**, the NYSE will provide customers with the opportunity to perform connectivity testing to the backup server at the Mahwah Data Center for the various Post Trade products and services. Customers can leverage existing IP addresses to access the data center for Post Trade products and services, and **will not** have to make any changes.

The NYSE recommends testing for customers who currently take part in any of the following functions:

- Autoroute Distribution – Test File will be sent to participating firms.
- Datatrak Submission (NDM / FTP) – Participating firms will send in a test file.
- MQ Users – Simple Ping Test to ensure connectivity.
- OCS TN3270 Users – Participating firms will get to the Logon screen to prove connectivity.

NOTE: For all input/output, file names and Product IDs will be set up when registering for the test.

The test will be conducted from 9:00 AM to 12:00 Noon on Saturday April 2nd, 2011.
